CONSTITUTION

- 1. The name of the society is Campbell River Genealogy Society, hereinafter known as "the society".
- 2. The purposes of the society are:
 - a) to promote the study of genealogy and genealogical research;
 - b) to encourage accurate, ethical and thorough research principles and techniques;
 - c) to maintain a library for the collection and preservation of information and artifacts pertaining to genealogy and local history;
 - d) to raise funds as may be needed for the operation of the society and its library;
 - e) to publish a regular newsletter containing genealogical and historical information;
 - f) to establish friendly relations with other organizations and genealogical societies for the exchange of ideas, information and the promotion of common interests;
 - g) to promote workshops, seminars and similar learning situations pertaining to genealogical research that may be useful to members and others in the community.
